Subscription Rates Annual membership in the Society for Molecular Biology and Evolution includes a subscription to *Molecular Biology and Evolution*. Memberships are payable in U.S. Individuals: \$80 for print only, \$40 for online only, \$100 for print and online; students (copy of student I.D. must be included): \$60 for print only, \$30 for online only, \$80 for print and online; family: \$90 for print only, \$45 for online only, \$110 for print and online. All subscriptions are on a calendar year basis and start with the January issue. AllenAir delivery is included in the rates for all subscriptions outside of North America.

Institutional subscriptions to the journal are at an annual rate of \$335.00 for online only and \$425 for print and online. Submission of Articles Publication in *Molecular Biology and Evolution* is open to members and non-members alike, and acceptance of papers for publication after editorial review is decided solely on the basis of merit and suitability.

Page Charges There is a charge of \$40 per page or fraction of a page for the first ten pages for publication in *MBE*. For each page over ten, the charge is \$80 per page. If the authors do not have the financial resources to cover these charges, a waiver of the charges may be requested of the Editor at the time that a manuscript is officially accepted for publication by the Editor. Page charges will not be waived for pages over ten. Page charges will not normally be waived unless an electronic version of the manuscript accompanies the final, printed version which the Associate Editor sends to the editorial office with a recommendation for acceptance. Articles are selected without regard to authors' ability to pay page charges.
